She was also a member of the trial team prosecuting *In re Bank of America Securities Litigation*, which resulted in a recovery of \$2.425 billion, the single largest securities class action recovery ever resolving violations of Sections 14(a) and 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act and one of the largest shareholder recoveries in history. She was recently recognized as a national "Rising Star" by *Law360* for her work in securities litigation. She was also named to *Benchmark Litigation*'s "Under 40 Hot List," which recognizes her as one the nation's most accomplished legal partners under the age of 40
