BLB&G Partner Rebecca Boon, Senior Counsel Michael Mathai, and Associate Kate Aufses will present to Harvard Law School students on "Fighting Workplace Sexual Harassment with BLB&G: Tracing the Harm from Jeffrey Epstein and Roger Ailes" on March 22, 2022. They will discuss how they prosecuted claims on behalf of shareholders against Twenty-First Century Fox's board for ignoring patterns of sex and race discrimination after employees filed sexual harassment claims against Roger Ailes, Bill O'Reilly, and others; and will further cover their suit against L Brands's board for permitting a culture of sexual misconduct after the disclosure of CEO Leslie Wexner's ties to Jeffrey Epstein.

Rebecca Boon is among the BLB&G attorneys who has become a thought leader on the issue, as seen in recent articles published in [Responsible Investor](#) and [Law360](#).
