BLB&G Partner Greg Varallo spoke at the 2025 Richard H. Walker '75 Chair in Business Law Lecture at Temple University's Beasley School of Law on March 25. Leading a presentation titled "Corporate Law as a Tool to Effect Social Change: Reflections of a Business Trial Lawyer," Greg reflected on his transition from a 36-year career at a leading Delaware defense firm to representing institutional investors at BLB&G. He discussed his role in some of the nation's most significant cases, including as co-lead counsel in the recent landmark case against Tesla that led to the rescission of Elon Musk's unprecedented \$56 billion compensation package.

Greg is the head of BLB&G's Delaware office, prosecuting cases in Delaware and nationwide and helping the firm's clients navigate complex derivative and class actions, business-to-business disputes, fiduciary litigation in bankruptcy court, and alternative dispute resolution.
